Special Remarks

- 1. Minimum 3 and maximum 10 participants
- 2. Only pure Indian classical songs should be used
- 3. Any known form of Indian classical dance may be performed purely or in fusion form
- 4. A maximum of 4 minutes (in total) to set up and clear out the settings.
- 5. All materials brought to the stage shall be cleared and taken away from the Kalamela premises
